Applications on the prescribed form are invited from eligible candidates for the Entrance Test for admission to 2-year Master of Hospital Management (MHM) programme (self supporting) (with an internship period of six months after the 2-year period) for the year 2009-10. The University reserves the right to change or modify any of the rules and regulations including the scheme of examination and the syllabi of the course at any time.

COLLEGE & SEATS

The course is offered by Vikrama Simhapuri University. The classes will be run in the premises of Narayana Hospitals, Nellore, under the University-Industry hub. The intake of the course is 30 seats. The Course will be run only if a minimum of 15 candidates join the course.

HOW TO APPLY

Incomplete applications and applications not in the prescribed proforma will be rejected. Applications received after the specified date will be summarily rejected and the cost of application will not be refunded. The University is not responsible for any postal delay or loss in postal transit.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Any graduate, MBBS, BAMS, BHMS, BNYS and BDS with minimum of 40% marks in the group subjects by any University recognized by the University Grants Commission. For candidates belonging to SC/ST category, a pass is sufficient.

COURSE DURATION

Minimum of Two years (4 semesters) and 6 months of compulsory internship to be completed within a maximum period of four years.

COURSE FEE

The course fee is **Rs.60,000/-** per year plus **Rs.2,000/-** towards Admission fee (one time only). At the time of admission the candidate has to pay a counseling fee of Rs.50/- (Rs.25/- for SC/ST candidates) and a recognition fee of Rs.125/- in case of degree holders of other universities. For SC/ST/BC/EBC candidates whose parents income is less than Rs.1,00,000/- the fee will be Rs.42,000/- Fee shall be paid on the day of the counseling. No extension of time will be given. Fee can be paid in cash or by DD on any nationalized bank drawn in favour of Registrar, Vikrama Simhapuri University payable at Nellore.

DRESS CODE

All the admitted candidates have to follow dress code as per norms of the Institutions and the cost shall borne by the student.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission is through an Entrance Test. Based on the rank secured in the Entrance Test and as per the reservations rules in vogue, admission will be given to successful candidates.

ENTRANCE TEST CENTRE

Venue: 1) Vikrama Simhapuri University, VR College Campus, Nellore
Date of Entrance Test: 20-09-2009 (Sunday) From 10.00 AM To 12.00 Noon

The Entrance Test will be of 120 minutes duration with 100 multiple choice questions. The question paper consists of five parts:

Section - I: Test of reasoning (20 questions for 20 marks)

- A – Identify the number which correctly fills the blank space.
- B – Matrices
- C - Deductions
- D - Inferences

Section – II: Numerical Ability (20 questions for 20 marks)

Section – III: A - English Comprehension and Usage (10 questions for 10 marks)

B - Reading Comprehension (10 questions for 10 marks)

Section – IV: Health and Hospital Knowledge (20 questions for 20 marks)

Section – V: General Knowledge (20 questions for 20 marks)

Along with the test booklet, a separate answer sheet will be provided with questions numbered 1-100 in separate boxes. Each Question will have 4 alternative choices marked as 1,2,3 and 4 with one correct answer. The correct answer (1,2,3 or 4) shall be written in the corresponding box given in the answer sheet. No overwriting is allowed.

QUALIFYING MARK

The qualifying mark in the Entrance Test for all candidates (except SC/ST) is 25. For candidates belonging to SC/ST communities, there will be no qualifying mark. There is no negative mark. Answers shall be marked on a separate sheet provided with the booklet.
