

Vikrama Simhapuri University :: Nellore

Vikrama Simhapuri University, Nellore, came into being, fulfilling the long-cherished dream of the people of Sri Potti Sriramulu Nellore district, on 25th June 2008 by G.O.Ms. No.89 Higher Education (U.E.II) Department dated 25th June 2008. Subsequently, the A.P. Gazette notified the establishment of the University by Act 29 of 2008 on 24th September 2008.

The University has instituted the following eight departments. In 2008–2009 the University started postgraduate courses in six subjects:

In the Departments of Marine Biology, Chemistry, English, and Social Work, six seats each, in addition to the sanctioned strength, are earmarked as **payment category** seats. The courses of study have been decided on the basis of factors like employability and relevance to the resources of the region. ISRO’s Satish Dhawan Space Centre nearby, the long coast line, fisheries industries, the upcoming Krishnapatnam Port, the new SEZs, the town’s history of the spread of journalism have all been taken into account in the devising of courses and specializations.

Admissions to the MBA and MCA courses will be made through ICET – 2009. Admissions to the 5-Year Integrated Course in Biotechnology will be made along with admissions to similar 5-Year Integrated Courses offered by Sri Venkateswara University, Tirupati shortly. A separate notification relating to this will be issued by SVU CET -2009 shortly.

All courses of study follow the UGC requirements and guidelines like the semester system and have a compulsory component of project work in the Second Year of the course, to give the students hands on experience and to attend to their skill development for the paving the way for their empowerment. Project Work / Field Work have to be executed by the student at his / her cost.

The University has created its website, www.simhapuriuniv.org. Admission notifications, other notifications, and news about the University will be placed on the website from time to time.

1. Admissions to the PG courses mentioned below will be held based on the rank obtained in the Common Entrance Test, SVUCET-09 conducted by Sri Venkateswara University.

2. Candidates seeking admission to Vikrama Simhapuri University, Nellore, should apply to the Director, Directorate of Admissions, Sri Venkateswara University, Tirupati.

4. Candidates can also submit their applications on-line from the web site www.svudoa.com.
5. All the admissions to courses in Vikrama Simhapuri University will be according to the rules and regulations given in SVUCET-09 Instruction Booklet.
6. Those candidates who have already applied for SVUCET-09 for Chemistry, Biotechnology, English, and Master of Social Work (MSW) need not apply again. Their applications will also be considered for admission to the courses in Vikrama Simhapuri University, Nellore.
7. Counselling for admission/sliding will be held at S.V. University, Tirupati, simultaneously with the admissions of SV University, as per the SVU admission rules given in the Instruction Booklet of SVUCET-09.
8. No separate application will be issued by VSU, Nellore.
9. Mere appearance at entrance test will not entitle the candidate for admission unless the stipulated eligibility conditions are satisfied.
