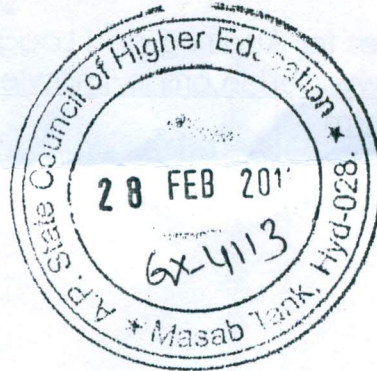

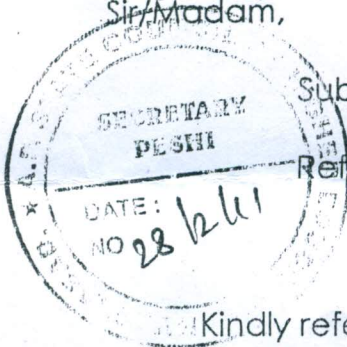

2. CERT-In, DIT, Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, New Delhi is tracking defacement of Indian websites on regular basis. A total of 1620 & 2054 Indian websites were defaced by various defacers during the month of October & November 2010 respectively. Similarly 288 & 348 number of websites have been compromised and links to malicious websites were planted on these sites during corresponding months.

3. In view of growing attacks on websites, you are requested to advise website administrators to follow best practices to secure web applications and web servers. For this the CERT-In security guidelines, it is requested to visit the following websites :

2. CSC (Common Service Center) Scheme was launched by Government of India under NeGP (National e Governance Plan) to set up one lakh CSCs in villages across the country with a vision of providing all Government and private services in an integrated manner at doorstep of the citizen, at an affordable cost. In the state of Andhra Pradesh the CSC scheme was named as "RAJIV Citizen Service Center (RCSCs)" where in a total of 4687 RCSCs are being established.

3. The Government vide reference cited above issued orders to all departments to utilize RAJiv Citizen Service Centres (RCSCs) for the delivery of Government services to the citizens and to identify minimum two G2C services to roll-out through RCSCs within the 6 (Six) months from the date of issue of the G.O. i.e. 27.10.2010. So far only Revenue, Transport, Commercial Tax and Civil Supplies Departments have identified the services. Other departments are yet to identify the services.

4. In view of above, you are requested to identify minimum two G2C services and communicate the same to IT&C Department at the earliest.

5. It is proposed to convene a review meeting on the subject by the Chief Secretary shortly.
